

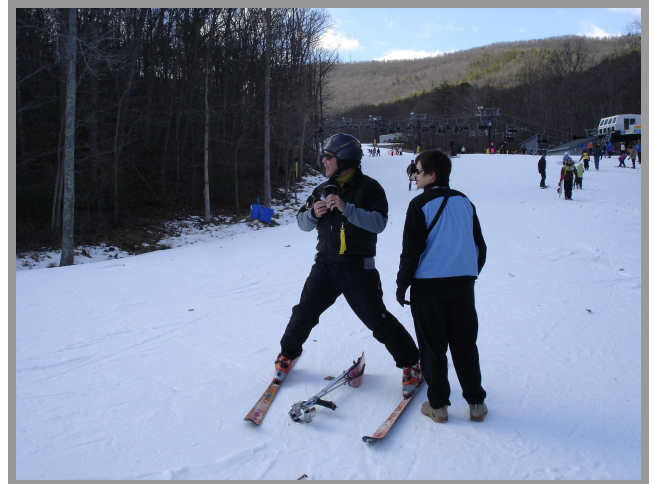
Leadership Profile

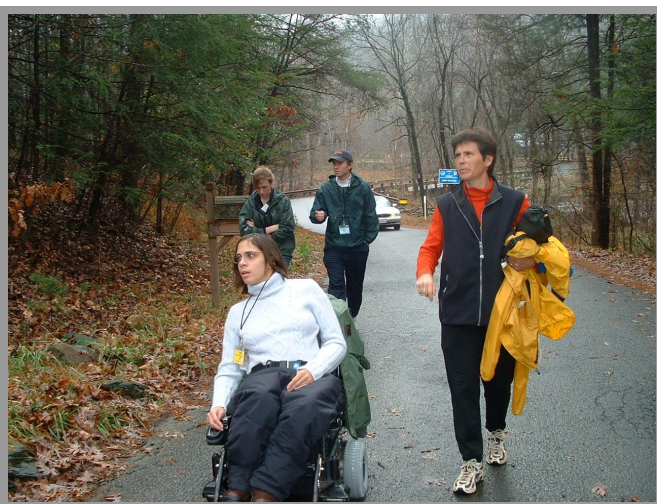
